Re: Covid-19 Vaccination Invitation Letter for parents/carers of children aged 12 to 15 years of age

I am writing to inform you that we will be offering COVID-19 vaccinations for children aged 12 to 15 years of age at Stratford School Academy.

I would like to ask if you wish to give your consent for your child to receive a single dose of the vaccine.

This vaccination will be free of charge and our highest priority is making it easy for children to access one dose of the vaccine before the winter.

The main purpose of the COVID-19 school age vaccination programme is to provide protection to the children who receive the vaccine, and it may also help to reduce transmission of COVID-19 in the wider population.

Vaccinations will be carried out by an NHS immunisation team. During vaccination delivery, the team will maintain the range of measures they have in place to keep you safe from COVID-19.
