Dear Parents/Carers,

Re: Covid Roadmap Update

As I am sure you are aware the government last night announced that it is delaying the complete removal of Covid restrictions for four weeks. This is due to several factors linked to the spread of the Delta variant. There has been no specific change in government guidance for schools and this change has a very limited impact on our current systems and processes. Students are still free to wear masks if they wish and should remember the continued importance of good hand hygiene and social distancing whenever possible. Whilst we have enjoyed a significant period of time with no cases in the school, we have now had two cases in the last two weeks – as ever, it is vital that our students and their families remain vigilant.

It is really important that families continue to do two lateral flow tests per week. Also if any of your children do show symptoms of Covid-19 please do not send them into school until they have received a negative test result (either lateral flow or PCR).

The overall number of cases in the school over time remains low and our attendance has been above both local and national averages for some time, so we remain confident about the effectiveness of the measures we have in place. I am very much hoping that we will be able to return to normal in September and the school is currently planning for the new academic year on this basis.
