Maths Curriculum Map

Each student has been given a Curriculum Map for the academic year. Students have been advised to glue this into the inside front cover of their Maths book. The curriculum map summarises all the topics that your child will be learning in each term of the 2021/22 academic year. This is especially useful if your child wants to revise these topics in advance.

Maths Homework

As a department, we have subscribed to two fantastic online revision tools: [MathsWatch](#) and [Hegarty Maths](#). Your child's Maths teacher will be setting Homework weekly, following the schedule outlined in the table below:
